76.271 Visitors from 106 Countries

WPM & Intermob Dynamized the Industry with a Record Number of Visitors in 2018

The fairs which are organised by Reed Tüyap with the cooperation of industrial associations, AIMSAD and MAKSDER; were highly acclaimed by the entire industry
